As we reflect on the past year, one truth stands out: the small, everyday moments families spend reading together truly shape tomorrow. Whether it's a bedtime story after a long day or five quiet minutes flipping through a favorite book, these moments nurture curiosity, confidence, and connection, laying the foundation for lifelong learning.

This year, we proudly brought our Always Reading program to over 4,700 pre-K, TK, and kindergarten students and their family members across Northern California and Hawai'i—a 31% increase in individuals served. We grew thoughtfully, adding Book Coaches who reflect the cultural backgrounds of the communities we serve, and listening closely to the needs of our school partners and families. In a time of uncertainty for many public schools, we were humbled by the trust placed in us, including a transformational \$500,000 gift from the Tsuha Hawai'i Aloha Fund, helping us deepen and expand our work where it's needed most.

Together, we're not only increasing access to books; we're empowering families with the tools and guidance needed to set their children up for success. With your continued support, we'll keep turning small reading moments today into brighter futures for thousands of children tomorrow.

Families Are Their First Teacher— We Just Equip Them



At Kristi Yamaguchi's Always Dream, we believe every family has the power to spark a lifelong love of reading—sometimes, they just need a little support to get started. Through our Always Reading program, we partner with caregivers as their child's first and most important teacher, offering tools, encouragement, and personalized guidance that fits into real life.

For us, success isn't measured only in numbers, it's seen in everyday victories: a parent sending a proud photo, a child asking for "just one more story," and families discovering that even small moments spent reading together can make a big difference.

A Habit That Changed Everything

This year, Book Coach Sofia worked with Amelia and her father, who was determined to make reading a habit, even when life felt overwhelming. Through text check-ins, phone calls, and curated book recommendations, Sofia helped the family carve out

small but meaningful reading moments together. By the end of the school year, those few minutes each week had added up to 85 total books read, and a daughter ready to enter first grade filled with pride and confidence.

Small Routines, Big Impact

Reading routines formed in early childhood lay the foundation for lifelong learning. When families regularly share stories, children strengthen their language skills, expand their imagination, and build emotional bonds that support school success.

By combining weekly encouragement from Book Coaches with access to thousands of diverse books, we help transform reading from something families feel they should do into something they look forward to doing together.
