As we reflect on the past year, one truth stands out: the small, everyday moments families spend reading together truly shape tomorrow. Whether it's a bedtime story after a long day or five quiet minutes flipping through a favorite book, these moments nurture curiosity, confidence, and connection, laying the foundation for lifelong learning.

This year in Hawai'i, we were proud to partner with 19 schools across four islands—O'ahu, Maui, Moloka'i, and Hawai'i Island—serving over 2,400 pre-K and kindergarten students and their family members through our Always Reading program. We deepened our roots in longtime partner communities and expanded to new schools on the Leeward Coast of O'ahu, in Lahaina on Maui, and at Nā'ālehu Elementary in Ka'ū. Across the islands, our Book Coaches, local educators who reflect the families they serve, walked alongside caregivers and teachers to turn access into action and create joyful reading routines at home.

In a time of uncertainty for many public schools, we were humbled by the trust placed in us, including a transformational \$500,000 gift from the Tsuha Hawai'i Aloha Fund, helping us deepen and expand our work where it's needed most across Hawai'i. Together with supporters like you, we're strengthening early literacy, family bonds, and a lifelong love of reading across Hawai'i. Mahalo for believing in the power of stories to shape a brighter future for all keiki.

At Kristi Yamaguchi's Always Dream, we believe every family has the power to spark a lifelong love of reading—sometimes, they just need a little support to get started. Through our Always Reading program, we partner with caregivers as their child's first and most important teacher, offering tools, encouragement, and personalized guidance that fits into real life.

A Habit That Changed Everything

This year, we brought our Always Reading program to Wai'anae Elementary on the westside of O'ahu. It was here we met Brae-Lyn and her mother Erica. With

the support of Book Coach Jen, Brae-Lyn's teacher Ms. Fujino, and family members, Erica worked diligently to build reading into Brae-Lyn's every day routine. Before long, Brae-Lyn was a Super Reader and her progress took off, transforming her learning journey and setting her up for success in first grade and beyond.





Engagement in Action: Building Reading Habits



Small Routines, Big Impact

Reading routines formed in early childhood lay the foundation for lifelong learning. When families regularly share stories, keiki strengthen their language skills, expand their imagination, and build emotional bonds that support school success.

By combining weekly encouragement from Book Coaches with access to thousands of diverse books, we help transform reading from something families feel they should do into something they look forward to doing together.
